

## Purpose

- To provide Medicare Advantage Organizations (MAOs) and other entities that are currently submitting encounter data with operational guidance on testing and submitting production data to the Encounter Data System (EDS).
- To provide new 2013 MAOs and other entities with resources and operational guidance related to certification and submission of encounter data to the EDS.
- To provide Medicare Advantage Organizations (MAOs) and other entities information on EDS policy.


## MAOs and Other Entities

- CMS requires the following types of organizations to submit encounter data:
- Medicare Advantage (MA) Plans
- Medicare Advantage-Prescription Drug (MA-PD) Plans
- Health Maintenance Organizations (HMOs)
- Special Needs Plans (SNPs)
- Local Preferred Provider Organizations (PPOs)
- Regional PPOs
- Employer Group Health Plans
- Programs of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly (PACE) Plans
- Cost Plans (1876 Cost HMOs/CMPs and 1833 HCPPs)
- Medical Savings Account (MSA) Plans
- Private Fee-for-Service (PFFS) Plans
- Religious Fraternal Benefit (RFB) Plans
- Provider Sponsored Organizations (PSOs)

## 277CA Formatting

- The 277CA Acknowledgement Reports distributed to FTP users during the first week of April were sent in the fixed format versus the variable format, which affected 34 of 56 submitters.
- FTP users that require 277CA Acknowledgement Reports redistributed in the variable format should contact CSSC Operations at (877) 534-2772.


## Invalid Response Reports

- On April 8, 2013, several MAOs and other entities received EDFES Invalid Response Reports with an error message, "Trading Partner Not Eligible to Submit Production".
- CMS has identified affected submitters and is currently reprocessing their files.

## Missing Contract IDs on MAO-002 Reports

- During the week of April 8, 2013, some MAOs and other entities received reprocessed MAO-002 Reports with missing contract IDs.
- CMS is analyzing the root cause of this issue and will provide the industry with an update once it becomes available. <br> \section*{Processing Updates} <br> \section*{Processing Updates}


## Retroactive Beneficiary Processing

- Based on the current EDPS processing and editing logic for eligibility and enrollment, beneficiaries that retroactively terminated from an MAO are not effectively identified in the EDS.
- The EDS Project team is currently reviewing options to identify retroactively terminated beneficiaries for all EDS submissions.
- MAOs and other entities will be notified once information is available.


## Void/Delete Processing

- Void/delete encounters should be edited based on validation edits to ensure that the data elements match those that are populated in the original submission.

Note: CMS is currently reviewing the editing logic to ensure that void/delete encounters are processed accordingly through the EDS.

## Highlight \#1 Valid/Accurate Diagnosis Codes

- Per the Official ICD-9 CM Guidelines for Coding and Reporting:
- A three-digit code is to be used only if it is not further subdivided.
- Where fourth-digit subcategories and/or fifth-digit sub classifications are provided, they must be assigned.
- A code is invalid if it has not been coded to the full number of digits required for that code.


## Highlight \#1 (conted)

## Valid/Accurate Diagnosis Codes Example

- Mary Sue went to the doctor because she noticed her skin was bronzing and she was having joint pains. Her doctor documented in the medical record that this was due to a genetic disorder. The provider submitted the encounter with a diagnosis of 275 (Disorders of Mineral Metabolism).
- The encounter was rejected because the diagnosis was not coded to the highest level of specificity. The encounter should have been submitted using the appropriate diagnosis code of 275.01 (Hereditary Hemochromatosis).
