Purpose

- To provide Medicare Advantage Organizations (MAOs) and other entities that are currently submitting encounter data with operational guidance on testing and submitting production data to the Encounter Data System (EDS).
- To provide new 2013 MAOs and other entities with resources and operational guidance related to certification and submission of encounter data to the EDS.
- To provide Medicare Advantage Organizations (MAOs) and other entities information on EDS policy.





MAOs and Other Entities

- CMS requires the following types of organizations to submit encounter data:
 - Medicare Advantage (MA) Plans
 - Medicare Advantage-Prescription Drug (MA-PD) Plans
 - Health Maintenance Organizations (HMOs)
 - Special Needs Plans (SNPs)
 - Local Preferred Provider Organizations (PPOs)
 - Regional PPOs
 - Employer Group Health Plans
 - Programs of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly (PACE) Plans
 - Cost Plans (1876 Cost HMOs/CMPs and 1833 HCPPs)
 - Medical Savings Account (MSA) Plans
 - Private Fee-for-Service (PFFS) Plans
 - Religious Fraternal Benefit (RFB) Plans
 - Provider Sponsored Organizations (PSOs)

CMS Updates





End-to-End Certification Status

 Of the 581 MAOs and other entities and 89 PACE Organizations that have submitted data for 2012, the following have achieved end-to-end certification:

MAO-002 Reports Update

- For all encounter data submissions, the EDS will return the MAO-002 Encounter Data Processing Status Reports to MAOs and other entities in the order that the files are received.
- The delay in receipt of MAO-002 Reports impacts 99 unique submitters.
- The EDPS is currently processing MAO-002 reports for data received on January 24, 2013.

EDFES Known Issues (cont'd.)

- The EDFES has corrected this issue.
- Submitters may now resubmit files impacted by this issue.





EDFES Known Issues (cont'd.)

- EDFES has instituted performance enhancements for data processed within the Professional and Institutional CEM to allow for timely processing of encounter files.
- The performance enhancements will assist in resolving the following Known Issue:
 - Full file rejects due to duplicate submission edit CSCC A8:CSC 746.

 Effective January 28, 2013, the required enhancements for the following EDPS edits were implemented in production:

EDPS Known Issues (cont'd.)

One (1) Known Issue is currently pending resolution:

Error Code	Error Code Description	Target Resolution Date
03102	Provider Type or Specialty Not Allowed to Bill Procedure • (Interim Resolution – Edit currently reflects an "Informational" status. Final resolution will cause Edit 03102 to reflect a "Reject" status.)	Final Resolution TBD

- The three (3) incidents remaining that were directly related to Known Issues were resolved with the implementation of the EDPS January maintenance release.

EDPS Edits

- Institutional files containing End-Stage Renal Disease (ESRD) encounters for TOB 72X will reject in the EDPS for the following:
 - Excessive values for weight and height in Loop 2300 HI segment where the value = BE (Value Code)
- Effective February 22, 2013, submitters will receive edit 27000 "Height or Weight Value Exceeds Limit":
 - For Value Code A8 for Patient's Weight
 - The weight submitted is greater than 318.2 kilograms (700 pounds).
 - For Value Code A9 for Patient's Height
 - The height submitted is greater than 228.6 centimeters (7 feet 6 inches).



EDS Operational Highlights





Highlight #1 Non-Renewal for 2013

- If a parent organization terminates **all** contracts with CMS effective 2013, the parent organization is not required to submit 2012 DOS.
- If a parent organization terminates one or more contracts with CMS, and still has remaining contracts, that parent organization must submit all 2012 DOS for the terminated and remaining contracts.





Highlight #2 Ambulance ZIP Code - Institutional

 For the submission of Institutional ambulance services, MAOs and other entities may provide the ZIP code for the Rendering Provider (or Billing Provider, if the Rendering Provider is the same as the Billing Provider) if the true ambulance pick-up ZIP code is not available.





Highlight #3 837-P Home Health Encounters

- Effective for July 2013 DOS and beyond, only Institutional Home Health encounters will be accepted.
- To determine a resolution for submission of Professional Home Health encounters, MAOs and other entities are encouraged to increase provider outreach activities to assist Home Health providers.





Highlight #4 EDS Diagnosis Level Editing

 The CEM requires that all diagnoses submitted to the EDS be coded to the highest level of specificity (maximum number of digits).





Highlight #5 PACE 2013 Encounter Submission

- PACE Organizations are not required to submit encounter data for 2012 DOS.
- Once PACE Organizations have achieved end-toend certification, they are required to submit production data for 2013 DOS.

Reminder:

 The PACE Certification deadline is February 28, 2013.





Highlight #6 Submission Frequency

- The minimum frequency of submission is based on enrollment size.
- MAOs and other entities may submit data as often as daily.

Number of Medicare Enrollees	Minimum Submission Frequency
Greater than 100,000	Weekly
50,000 – 100,000	Bi-weekly
Less than 50,000	Monthly

Industry Feedback Request – Part B Drugs & Foreign Providers

- CMS is currently evaluating EDS guidelines that will allow the collection of encounter data for Part B Drug data and Foreign Provider services.
- In order to determine appropriate requirements for EDS submission of Part B Drugs and Foreign Providers, CMS is requesting feedback from MAOs and other entities.





Industry Feedback Request – Part B Drugs & Foreign Providers (cont'd.)

Part B Drugs

- Provide information regarding the percentage of professional claims submitted in the NCPDP format.
 - Of those claims, how many include valid NDC codes.
- Submit the information to <u>eds@ardx.net</u>.
 - Place in the subject line "NCPDP with NDC".

Foreign Providers

- Provide information regarding the percentage of claims received from foreign providers.
- Submit the information to <u>eds@ardx.net</u>.
 - Place in the subject line "Foreign Provider Volume".

EDFES Acknowledgement Reports Overview





EDFES Acknowledgement Reports Overview

- When MAOs and other entities submit encounters, the EDFES performs file format and integrity checks at the translator and CEM levels.
 - The translator performs syntax and HIPAA Implementation Guide (IG) edits and generates the TA1 and 999 Acknowledgement Reports.
 - TA1 Acknowledgement Report identifies issues in the Interchange control structure that cause the file to reject.
 - 999 Acknowledgement Report identifies the processing status of the Functional Group and Transaction Set within the file.





EDFES Acknowledgement Reports Overview (cont'd.)

- When a file passes the translator level editing process,
 the CEM performs Medicare IG edits and generates the
 277CA Acknowledgement Report for accepted and
 rejected encounters.
- An Internal Control Number (ICN) is assigned to all accepted encounters, which are forwarded to the EDPS.
 - The 277CA Acknowledgement Report provides notification to the submitter regarding the status of their files after CEM processing.
 - Accepted an EDS ICN is assigned.
 - Rejected no ICN is assigned; errors are reflected on the report.



TESTING AND PRODUCTION FILE NAME COMPONENTS DESCRIPTON

File Name Component	Description
RSPxxxxx	The type of data 'RSP' and a sequential number assigned by the RISC 'xxxxx'
X12xxxxx	The type of data 'X12' and a sequential number assigned by the RISC 'xxxxx'
TMMDDCCYYHHMMS	The Date and Time stamp the file was processed by the RISC
999xxxxx	The type of data '999' and a sequential number assigned by the RISC 'xxxxx'
RPTxxxxx	The type of data 'RPT' and a sequential number assigned by the RISC 'xxxxx'
RPT/ZIP	Determines if the file is a plain text 'RPT' or compressed 'ZIP'
XXXXXXX	Seven (7) characters available to be used as a short description of the contents of the file
RPT/FILE	Identifies if the file is a formatted report 'RPT' or a flat file 'FILE' layout
