#### Introduction

The purpose of this session is to provide Medicare Advantage Organizations (MAOs) and other entities with information on policy and operational guidance on testing and submitting production data to the Encounter Data System (EDS).





#### **MAOs and Other Entities**

- CMS requires the following types of organizations to submit encounter data:
  - Medicare Advantage (MA) Plans
  - Medicare Advantage-Prescription Drug (MA-PD) Plans
  - Health Maintenance Organizations (HMOs)
  - Special Needs Plans (SNPs)
  - Local Preferred Provider Organizations (PPOs)
  - Regional PPOs
  - Employer Group Health Plans
  - Programs of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly (PACE) Plans
  - Cost Plans (1876 Cost HMOs/CMPs and 1833 HCPPs)
  - Medical Savings Account (MSA) Plans
  - Private Fee-for-Service (PFFS) Plans
  - Religious Fraternal Benefit (RFB) Plans
  - Provider Sponsored Organizations (PSOs)

### CMS Updates





#### **End-to-End Certification Status**

 Of the 219 total submitter IDs that were actively enrolled for EDS submission in 2012, the following submitters have achieved end-to-end certification:

#### **EDS Reports Update**

- Certain MAOs and other entities have experienced delays in receipt of EDFES Acknowledgement Reports due to an interruption in FFS CEM processing.
  - CSSC has submitted a request to CMS to determine the root cause of this interruption.
- CMS previously notified MAOs and other entities that the EDS will undergo enhancements to optimize the EDPS performance.
  - Submitters will experience some delays in receipt of MAO-002 reports during these enhancements.
  - These delays will decrease as enhancements are implemented.

# EDFES Invalid Response Reports – Special Notifications





### EDFES Invalid Response Reports – Special Notifications

- The EDFES distributes special notifications to submitters when encounters have been processed by the EDFES but will not proceed to EDPS for further processing.
- These notifications are distributed to MAOs and other entities, in addition to standard EDFES
   Acknowledgement Reports, in order to avoid returned, unprocessed files from the EDS.

#### **EDPS Incident Tracking**

- Of the 401 incidents previously submitted to the EDS Incident Tracking Tool, three (3) are currently pending resolution.
  - These pending incidents are directly related to Known Issues and will be resolved with the January maintenance release.

 MAOs and other entities should access the quarterly CEM Edits Spreadsheets according to this schedule to ensure appropriate and timely updates to their internal programming systems.



#### EDFES Edits (cont'd)

- The January 2013 FFS CEM quarterly release will include new EDFES edits to reject encounters with multiple Primary Payer Paid Amount Segments (AMT01 = D) when true COB encounters are submitted.
- Effective January 11, 2013, EDS will deactivate the following edits to allow for submission of tertiary (true COB) encounters:
  - X223.364.2320.AMT.040 (Part A-Institutional)
    - o If 2000B.SBR01 = "S" then only one iteration of 2320 loop containing an AMT with AMT01 equal to 'D' is allowed.
  - X222.305.2320.AMT.040 (Part B-Professional)
    - o If 2000B.SBR01 = "S" then only one iteration of 2320 loop containing an AMT with AMT01 equal to 'D' is allowed.





#### EDFES Edits (cont'd.)

- The January 2013 FFS CEM quarterly release also includes a new EDFES edit to reject encounters populated and submitted with an Insured Group or Policy Number that was implemented early.
- Effective January 14, 2013, the EDS will deactivate the following edit:
  - X223.109.2000B.SBR03.004 (Part A-Institutional)

#### **EDPS Edits**

- Edit 03101 Invalid Gender for Procedure Code
  - Disposition status of this edit will be changed from "reject" to "informational".
  - CMS will notify MAOs and other entities when this enhancement is implemented.
- Edit 32001 Bill Type Not Implemented for Processing at This Time
  - This edit has been deactivated.
  - Effective immediately, MAOs and other entities may submit all valid bill types for Institutional encounter data.





#### **EDPS Edits**

- Several MAOs and other entities were receiving the following EDPS edits due to defects in the Member table indexes.
  - Edit 02110 Beneficiary HICN Not on File
  - Edit 02255 Beneficiary Not Part A Eligible for DOS
- Member tables were corrected on January 5, 2013.
- EDPS is currently reprocessing associated files and redistributing MAO-002 reports.
- CSSC is contacting Submitters affected by the defect.



#### 2011 DOS Submission





#### 2011 DOS Submission

- Beginning January 10, 2013, MAOs and other entities may begin submitting encounters containing 2011 "from" DOS.
  - Encounters must contain 2012 "through" DOS.
  - Encounters that contain 2011 "from" AND "through" DOS will not be accepted.
- CMS will consider the effects that the delayed submission may have on the Catch-up Production data deadlines.





## Timely Filing for 2012 DOS





#### **Timely Filing for 2012 DOS**

 MAOs and other entities must submit adjudicated encounters for 2012 DOS to the EDS according to the 13-month timely filing guidance:

| Submission Type                | Timely Filing Deadline   |  |
|--------------------------------|--|--|
| Full Encounters                | <ul> <li>13 months from the DOS</li> <li>Institutional – "Through" DOS</li> <li>Professional – Service Line DOS</li> </ul> |  |
| Adjustment Encounters          | 30 days after the adjudication date  |  |
| <b>Chart Review Encounters</b> | Within 25 months of the data collection period   |  |





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## Ambulance Services – Mileage





#### **Ambulance Services – Mileage**

- When submitting encounters for Ambulance services, MAOs and other entities should report mileage in fractional units.
- Fractional mileage units should be rounded to the nearest tenth of a mile.
  - For example:
    - 7.47 miles should be reported as 7.5 miles.
    - o 69.32 miles should be reported as 69.3 miles.

## EDS Inbox Submissions





**Q**: What is the termination date for Tier 2 and Tier 3 testing?

**A:** Currently there is no projected termination date for Tier 2 testing. Tier 2 testing was designed to allow MAOs and other entities the opportunity to test a large sampling of their data when necessary due to internal system changes or changes within the encounter data. Tier 3 testing was for a specific date span and has since been discontinued.





**Q**: Will CMS include anesthesia modifier 'QS' (monitored anesthesia care) to the list of acceptable modifiers?

**A**: Anesthesia modifier 'QS' is an acceptable modifier; however, it should not be populated in the primary procedure modifier field.

When submitting procedure codes 00100-01999, a primary anesthesia modifier (AA, AD, QK, QX, QY, or QZ) must be populated in the primary procedure modifier field.

Modifier 'QS' should only be reported as an additional modifier ( $2^{nd} - 4^{th}$  modifier) in addition to one of the listed primary modifiers.



**Q**: Can you confirm if paper generated encounters and EDI encounters are validated using the same edits in the EDFES?

A: All encounter data submissions are validated using the same CEM edits regardless of whether the claim was originally received in a paper format or EDI. MAOs and other entities must submit at least the Minimum Data Elements to ensure encounters pass EDFES edits.





**Q**: Can MAOs and other entities submit 2013 DOS or is there a scheduled date to begin 2013 DOS submission?

A: MAOs and other entities that have obtained endto-end certification may submit encounters with 2013 DOS as they are received and adjudicated.

**Note**: The EDS experienced a brief period where 2013 DOS were rejecting in the system. This issue has been corrected.





**Q**: Should MAOs and other entities populate Loop 2320 AMT02 (payer paid amount) with other carrier amount when the claim is paid by workers' compensation or subrogation?

**A**: Yes, for all COB encounters, including workers' compensation and subrogation, Loop 2320 AMT02 must be populated.
