# Introduction

The purpose of this session is to provide Medicare Advantage Organizations (MAOs) and other entities with information on policy and operational guidance on testing and submitting production data to the Encounter Data System (EDS)

# MAOs and Other Entities

- CMS requires the following types of organizations to submit encounter data:
  - Medicare Advantage (MA) Plans
  - Medicare Advantage-Prescription Drug (MA-PD) Plans
  - Health Maintenance Organizations (HMOs)
  - Special Needs Plans (SNPs)
  - Local Preferred Provider Organizations (PPOs)
  - Regional PPOs
  - Employer Group Health Plans
  - Programs of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly (PACE) Plans
  - Cost Plans (1876 Cost HMOs/CMPs and 1833 HCPPs)
  - Medical Savings Account (MSA)
  - Private Fee-for-Service Plans (PFFS)
  - Religious Fraternal Benefit Plans (RFBs)
  - Provider Sponsored Organizations (PSO)

# End-to-End Certification Status

## Certification Status as of 08/28/2012\*

<b>219 Total Submitters/ 586 MAOs and Other Entities</b>	<b>Professional</b>	<b>Institutional</b>	<b>DME</b>
Number of Submitters Certified	<b>193</b>	<b>72</b>	<b>29</b>
Certified MAOs and Other Entities Represented	<b>547</b>	<b>328</b>	<b>123</b>

# End-to-End Testing / Certification Timeline

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	Testing Begins	Testing Ends/Deadline for Certification
Professional Encounters	1/4/2012	5/31/2012
Institutional Encounters	4/30/2012	8/31/2012
DME Encounters	6/15/2012	8/31/2012

- CMS will not begin compliance measures without advance notice; however, the End-to-End Testing/Certification timeline has not changed
- MAOs and other entities that have not completed end-to-end testing should do so immediately

# Production Submission Status

## Production Submission Status: May 1, 2012 – August 28, 2012\*

Percentage Rejected	<b>4%</b>

# System Volume/ Stress Testing Updates

# System Volume/Stress Testing

- Professional files were collected to perform system volume/stress testing on the EDS, which included 197,635 encounters
- Encounters in these files passed CEM level editing and were sent to the EDPS on August 15, 2012

# System Volume/Stress Testing

- The files were processed by the EDPS as follows:

	Total Encounters	Encounters Accepted	Encounters Rejected
File 1	44,355	43,212 (97%)	1,143 (3%)
File 2	53,933	50,535 (94%)	3,398 (6%)
File 3	54,616	51,986 (95%)	2,630 (5%)
File 4	44,731	43,126 (96%)	1,605 (4%)
<b>TOTALS</b>	<b>197,635</b>	<b>188,859 (96%)</b>	<b>8,776 (4%)</b>

- In the near future, CMS will notify MAOs and other entities of the findings regarding edits received on these encounters

# EDS Incident Tracking and Known Issues

# Incident Tracking Tool

- As of August 30, 2012, 295 incident inquiries have been received

## # of Incidents

Resolved	262 (88%)	
Pending	33 (12%)	28 of the 33 incidents are related to known issues and are being investigated or resolved

- From August 21, 2012 through August 30, 2012, twelve (12) known issues were finalized, resulting in the resolution of 39 incidents
- MAOs and other entities are encouraged to submit incident reports when edits are received on MAO-002 reports

# EDPS Reports Updates

# EDPS Reports Updates

- Effective September 4, 2012, the EDPS reports generated and distributed to MAOs and other entities will contain enhancements to more effectively interpret the status of encounters submitted to the EDS
  - MAO-001 Encounter Data Duplicates Report (new report)
  - MAO-002 Encounter Data Processing Status Report
- CMS will provide flat file and formatted report samples in order for MAOs and other entities to test their internal processing systems for accurate receipt and reconciliation

# EDPS Reports Updates

- Four (4) sample EDPS reports will be provided for MAOs and other entities to test their parsing logic to assist in retrieval of the MAO-001 Duplicates Report and enhanced MAO-002 Processing Status Report
- The sample reports include:
  - MAO-001 Encounter Data Duplicates Report – Flat File
  - MAO-001 Encounter Data Duplicates Report – Formatted
  - MAO-002 Encounter Processing Status Report (enhanced)– Flat File
  - MAO-002 Encounter Processing Status Report (enhanced)– Formatted

# 2011 Dates of Service Solution

# 2011 DOS Solutions

- CMS will implement an enhancement that will allow MAOs and other entities to submit encounters with “*from*” dates of service (DOS) for 2011 and “*through*” DOS for 2012
  - All Professional, Institutional, and DME
    - Exclude Home Health, SNF, and Swing Bed encounters until further guidance is provided
  - Interim Bills with final bill through DOS for 2012
- If 2011 through DOS lines are submitted, a line level rejection will be reflected on the MAO-002 report
- The EDPS will only process 2012 through DOS encounter lines

# 2011 DOS Solutions

- MAOs and other entities must **not** submit encounters with “from” and “through” 2011 DOS
- CMS will notify MAOs and other entities when the enhancements are in place and implemented for the 2011 DOS solution
