



## Edit Resolution Updates

CMS has enhanced the edit logic for the submission of Professional and Institutional encounter data. Enhancements were implemented on July 13<sup>th</sup>. MAOs and other entities may begin submitting files on July 18<sup>th</sup>. The following guidance has been issued for Professional Production Data and Test Case Data:

- **Professional Production Data** – MAOs and other entities should resubmit only those rejected encounters associated with system enhancements.
- **Professional and Institutional Test Case Data** – MAOs and other entities may submit only those rejected test cases that were associated with system enhancements.

The edits listed in **Table 1** have been resolved. MAOs and other entities with rejected lines and encounters pertaining to these edits may resubmit according to the guidance provided above.

## DME Test Case Updates

**TC02**-Incident to Services has been revised. MAOs and entities must submit a DME encounter with a DMEPOS Supplier HCPCS code selected from the DME Fee schedule located at:

MAOs and other entities must use the DMEPOS HCPCS codes within the 'JURIS' (column D) = "D" and submit a Provider NPI with a Payer ID 80881 or 80882.

- This should result in a rejection.
