



DME Production Data

The Encounter Data DME Processing and Pricing System (EDDPPS) will undergo system enhancements for **DME production data submission only**. As a result, there will be no DME production data processing between now and 9/24/12. EDFES acknowledgement reports will be distributed within 48 hours of submission; however, the system enhancements will impact the delivery of DME production MAO-002 reports. MAOs and other entities submitting DME production data prior to 9/24/2012 can expect to receive MAO-002 reports by October 1, 2012. The EDDPPS system enhancements will not impact the processing or report delivery time of DME test data.



2012 Terminated MAOs and Other Entities

For calendar year 2012 only, MAOs and other entities terminating their contract **effective** January 2013 are not required to submit 2012 encounter data.
