MAO-002 Encounter Data Processing Status Reports

- The EDPS is currently processing MAO-002 reports for data received on March 29, 2013.
- If your organization has not received your MAO-002 reports for files submitted prior to March 29, 2013, please contact CSSC Operations for assistance, after verifying receipt of EDFES Acknowledgement reports.

EDFES Known Issues

277CA Acknowledgement Reports - Delay

- MAOs and other entities may have experienced a delay in receipt of 277CA Acknowledgement reports as of March 22, 2013.
- 277CA Acknowledgement reports affected by this known issue from April 1 April 3, 2013, were processed and distributed to submitters.

277CA Acknowledgement Reports - Formatting

- The 277CA Acknowledgement reports distributed to FTP users during the first week of April were sent in the fixed format versus the variable format, which affected 34 of 56 submitters.
- FTP users that require 277CA Acknowledgment reports redistributed in the variable format should contact CSSC Operations at (877) 534-2772.

EDPS Edits Lookup Tool

- CMS is currently working to develop an online tool for MAOs and other entities to review and access the EDPS edits and the full descriptions for the edits.
- CMS will provide updates as the EDPS Edits Tool is developed and will notify MAOs and other entities when the tool is available for access and reference.

Encounter Adjustments

- When resubmitting encounters due to errors received on the generated MAO-002 reports:
 - MAOs and other entities should submit only the encounters that require reconciliation/correction.
 - Submission of a complete file for reconciliation/correction will cause the submitter to receive edit 98325 – Service Line(s) Duplicated.
