Report Description

The FERAS Response report indicates that a file has been accepted or rejected by the front-end system. This report identifies reasons for rejection. Various series edits are performed on different records:


100-199 Series are File level errors on the AAA or ZZZ records.

200-299 Series are Batch level errors on the BBB or YYY records.

300-399 Series are checks performed on the first and last CCC records.

If any errors result from this check, the file is rejected, the file does not continue to the next processing step, and the submitter must correct and resubmit.


