## Risk Adjustment Processing System (RAPS) – Return File

### Report Description

The RAPS Return File is a flat file format that includes all the records and diagnosis clusters submitted by the MAO or other entity. Any errors identified during the RAPS process will appear next to the field in which the error was found. All submitted records from the input file are returned in this report, both those with and without errors. The flat file may be used to analyze, and to establish a record of each diagnosis that was stored in the Risk Adjustment model for each enrollee.

This report identifies reasons for rejection or provides informational messages using a series of edit codes:

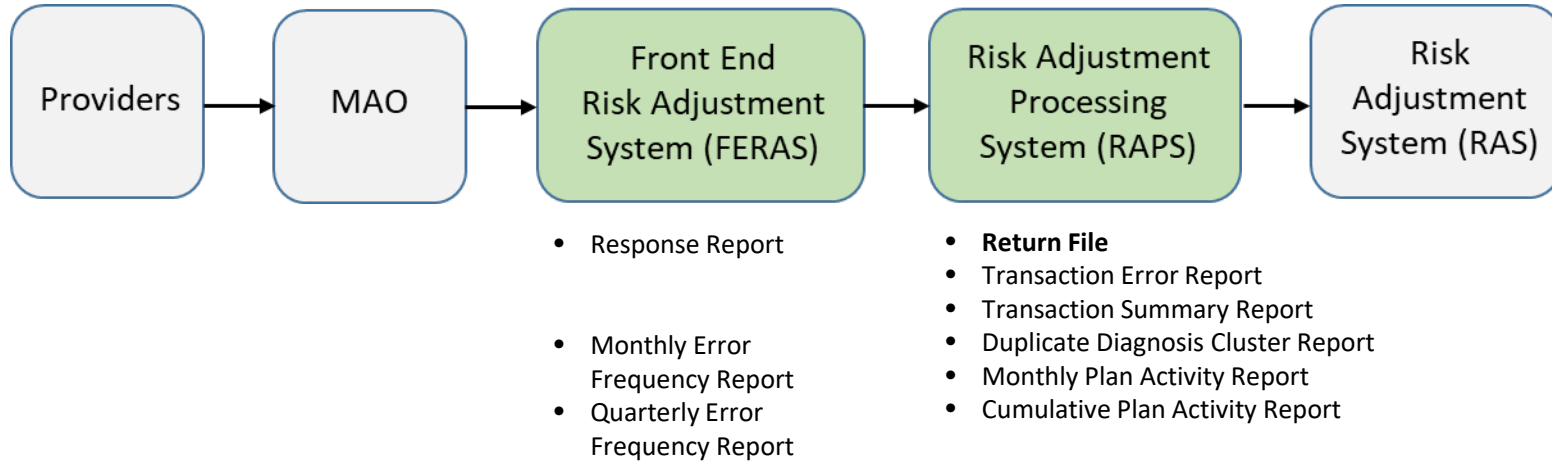
- 300 - 349 Series are for record-level errors. The record was bypassed and all editing was discontinued. No diagnosis clusters from this record were stored.
- 350 - 399 Series are for record-level errors. All possible edits were performed, but no diagnosis clusters from this record were stored.
- 400 - 489 Series are for Diagnosis cluster errors. All possible diagnosis edits were performed, but the diagnosis cluster is not stored; checks performed on the first and last CCC records.
- 490 - 499 Series are for Diagnosis delete errors; diagnosis was not deleted.
- 500 - 599 Series generates informational messages. All edits were performed; diagnosis cluster was stored unless some other error is noted.

This report is available in a flat file format that enables automated processing.
